Mr. Redmon of Arizona introduced the following bill;

A BILL

This bill is to repeal useless legislation passed years ago that serves no purpose to the US or her citizens and to also abolish many of the bureaucratic agencies that have no constitutional powers or authority.

Be it enacted by The American Legion Boys Nation Senate assembled,

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the "Restoring America Act".

SECTION 4. ABOLISHMENT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

- (a) Effective on the date that is 30 days after the date of this enactment of this Act-
 - (1) the Department of Education shall be abolished;
 - (2) each program applicable under the department shall be nulled and voided;

(3) the Secretary of Treasurer shall establish programs to allocate money to states to support elementary and secondary education;

(3a) the allocations made shall be proportionate to the amount of taxes paid by the residents of said state.

SECTION 5. ABOLISHMENT OF THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

- (a) Effective on the date that is 1 year after the date of this enactment of this Act-
- (1) the Federal Bureau of Investigation shall be abolished;
- (2) powers of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Director of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and any other officer of the Federal Bureau of Investigation shall be transferred and vested in Department of Homeland Security and the Secretary and any officials necessary;
- (3) 1 year after after the effective date of this Act, the Director of National Intelligence, in consultation with the Director of Federal Bureau of Investigation and any other relevant officials, shall transmit to Congress for effecting the transfer of functions and administering those functions. In designing this plan the Director shall consult Congress and the President's Foreign Intelligence Advisory Board.

SECTION 6. REPEALING OF THE PUBLIC BROADCASTING ACT OF 1967

- (a) The Public Broadcasting Act of 1967 shall be repealed;
- (b) the Corporation for Public Broadcasting shall be privatized.

SECTION 7. ABOLISHMENT OF THE SMALL BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

(a) The Small Business Administration is hereby abolished.

SECTION 8. REPEALING OF THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS ACT

(a) The Telecommunications Act of 1934 is hereby repealed;

- (b) the Telecommunication Act of 1996 is hereby repealed;
- (c) the Federal Communications Commissions is hereby abolished.
