IN THE SENATE OF THE AMERICAN LEGION BOYS NATION

Mr. Young of Ohio submitted the following resolution;

RESOLUTION

To change the method of election for the President of the United States of America to direct majority vote.

SECTION 2.

The following article is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of the United States of America, which shall be valid to all intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America (two-thirds of each House concurring therein) and when ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several States within seven years after the date of submission for ratification:

ARTICLE--

The President of the United States of America shall not be elected by representative electors from each state, but by a direct majority vote from the voting eligible population of the United States of America. If no candidate receives a majority of votes, a new election will be held with only the two candidates that received the largest shares of votes. This run-off election will take place before the

start of the next year.
